Adverse Weather Condition Guideline

If adverse weather conditions exist and the Sussex Hamilton School District has closed its schools or cancelled their activities, the recreation programs and events are cancelled. In most cases, the recreation staff is required to report for work regardless of these closings, so we may be available to help answer questions.

Should adverse weather conditions be eminent or exist, the recreation staff will post notification of the cancellations or changes in the most appropriate manner. We contact local TV stations to announce these closings. Tune in to obtain potential closings. Should adverse weather conditions exist or are eminent, the responsibility lies with the individual to inquire about potential closings and cancellations.

Every effort will be made to give reasonable, prudent and advanced notice to the registered participants by any of the following ways:

- Taglines on the local television stations
- Placing notices on the village's website: www.village.sussex.wi.us
- Placing notice on the village's cable TV channel
- Posting announcements on entrances to the parks or facilities, and
- Posting on the village's Facebook and Twitter accounts
